1. Title 1 Annual Parent Meeting: The Parent and Family Engagement Policy has been jointly developed and agreed upon by the staff and the School Organizational Team (SOT) at Sister Robert Joseph Bailey Elementary School.

Bailey Elementary's Title 1 Annual Parent meeting is scheduled for September 3, 2024, along with our Open House and September 18, during our SOT meeting. The agenda will also be posted on the school's website for any that were unable to attend.

2. The Annual District Survey Results: These results reflected that 83% of parents feel that our school administrators take prompt action when student problems occur. To continue and strengthen our schools behavior management, we will continue to follow the PBIS Behavior Management to enforce positive student behaviors. These survey results are shared with our parents through the Title 1 Annual Parent Meeting. All the results from the parent survey assist in developing our school's plan and how to best inform and involve our parent community.

3. Parent Involvement: Bailey Elementary will collaborate with parents regarding opportunities to be involved with making decisions that will ultimately affect family involvement and student achievement. Families will receive prior notice of meetings for the School Improvement Team and School Organizational Team (SOT) to assist with planning, implementing, and evaluating the effectiveness of the Title 1 budget and resources. Feedback from parent evaluations of involvement and engagement activities will be considered in planning future activities.

4. Accords: The Educational Involvement Accords are integrated into the registration process through Infinite Campus. Parents must review accords prior to completing their child's registration. Administrators and teachers will have access to and provide the accords whenever needed for parent/student conferences or other occasions..

5. Understanding Academic Topics: The administration and staff at Sister Bailey will provide assistance to aid parents with understanding such topics as:

6. Understanding Academic Topics: Parents will have daily access to students' grades and progress through the Infinite Campus parent portal. Grades are updated on a weekly basis, and meetings can be scheduled with teachers, administration, and specialists to discuss a student's progress.

High-quality instruction and resources will be provided to students that will enable them to achieve the targets for the Nevada Academic Content Standards. K-5 grade level teachers, specialists, and strategies collaborate weekly to plan and implement effective literacy lessons for Tier 1 instruction according to the Literacy Instruction Framework. Topics also include setting grade level and individual student learning goals, equity and diversity, conducting an effective parent conference, working with parents to improve attendance, and the expectations of the Read by Three Law (SB391).

7. Programs of Support to Parent Community: The school will educate the staff at Bailey with the process of communication to support the parent community. Weekly staff meetings and Staff Development Days will be utilized to discuss and train staff with strategies that will assist building and developing parent and family relationships. The school Social Worker, nurse, and staff will refer and/or coordinate with other communities, job, housing, educational, and health-related resources for parents, such as HopeLink of Southern Nevada, Family and Community Engagement Services (FACES), Title 1 Hope, Operation School Bell, The Cunningham Medical Clinic, vision and dental services, and Serving Our Kids weekend backpack food service. Brochures and posters about these services are available at the front entrance of the school.

Parents and families can attend Spread the Word Nevada Workshops for reading literacy, Family Literacy/Math Night, Parent Teacher Conferences and will be provided with training, strategies, and materials they can use at home that will enhance student learning and engagement to increase student achievement in all academic areas.

The key to the success of Sister Robert Joseph Bailey Elementary School is a collaborative team effort with our parent community, administration, teachers, staff, and students. If any additional information, support, or help is needed, parents are welcome to contact our school.
